



Nothing in this MOU shall be constructed to make party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.





2. The parties intent to co-operate and focus their efforts on co-operation within the area of scientific learning and experiment handling.




3. This co-operation will facilitate effective affiliation of the intellectual capabilities of their faculties, providing significant inputs to them in developing optimal learning system.


Termination:



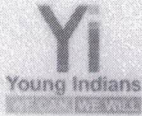

NOW THEREFORE, BOTH THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS UNDER

ARTICLE I: Purpose and Objectives

Both the Parties, by way of this MOU express their commitment to collaborate with each other to:

ARTICLE VIII: Governing Law, Jurisdiction & Arbitration


